New Business:

- Funding Vote Required -
 - Looking to pass funding for sexual health education for all except one division \$TBC (aprox \$3400 is total cost)
 - Whatever isn't funded by PAC would need to be covered by school. Prefer not to go to parents directly to cover cost.
 - Krista (Treasurer):
 - \$\$ would need to come from Fall Fund Drive \$\$ (only place we have wiggle room for contribution). Can't use gaming because this is a curriculum item.
 - Need to ensure we have \$\$ in our accounts for Fall 2022 so need to think about potential fundraising opps for the rest of the year. Thinking of some kind of virtual fundraiser or outdoor event where we can gather safely...want to raise funds so we can start the school year with teachers having continued funding similar to past years.
 - We aren't in a situation where we have a large surplus as we have in past years.
 - Krista (Treasurer): think we could contribute \$2500 if not the full amount. But it puts
 us in a bigger deficit in our planning for next year.
 - We will propose funding \$2500 and Carrie says she will cover the remainder with \$\$ from the school's budget.
 - Carrie will provide an invoice to Krista.

Motion to approve **\$2500** for Sexual Health Education for all divisions (except one) and the remainder will be covered by school budgetary funds: Leigh Anne Palmer

Second: Jessica Zallen

- Looking to pass \$307 for Livingstone participation in a parent education session with <u>Dr. Shimi Kang</u>, on **March 9th at 7pm**, that looks at resetting healthy tech habits to focus on learning, connection, self-care and adaptability. This will be a 1-hour, interactive session, with 9 additional schools in the VSB. The \$307 fee will go towards a donation to the Dolphin Kids Free Program. **\$307 Dr. Shimi Kang parent education**
- Specific topics addressed include:
 - How tech is impacting your child's brain, body and behaviour
 - How to differentiate between healthy, stressful and addictive tech experiences
 - How to reset your child's habits
 - Guidelines on how to maintain your child's habits at home/school during the pandemic and beyond with downloadable reset resources
- Krista (Treasurer): think this can come from gaming account
- Event will be posted on the FB and website so we can hopefully get as many parents participating as possible.
