East Van Soiree - Feb 29 - \$20K raised (10K per school)

There is still \$\$ coming in and out. Will report back to Krista and Vanessa
Seismic Upgrade meeting after PAC tonight

If people are talking about it - encourage them to participate and join committee, get involved, and join the in-life conversation. After the VSB press conference, only 48 surveys were completed. 29 expressed concerns about accessibility and now the VSB is looking for money to install elevator

How can people get involved? Is there a way to tell people how they can get involved? There has been a lot of correspondence. Andrew is leading a committee, people can still reach out to help even if they can't commit to the committee

Teachers often keep receipts until the end of the year Most teachers are spending all of the money PAC allocates to them

Budget for 2020/21 school year

Some leftover monies that we are proposing to put towards things the school needs iPads, keyboards, iPad pens and sports equipment

Amount is approximately \$6970 from PAC and the school will pay the balance.

Chris - how many iPads do we currently have?

Carrie is currently doing inventory - there are a lot of old generation inventory and the distribution is not equitable across the school. Most classes have 6-8. There are 123 in the school total. Many are old.

We did a survey to ask teachers where \$\$ should be allocated to and the majority said that they wanted iPads in classrooms

John - Mitzel bought a lot of iPads, Peeters did inventory, now we're buying more...feels like we're going back and forth in terms of priorities

Carrie - the need is based on the current curriculum, which has technology threaded through it. Apps are so much better and powerful. Kids are much more technology literate. iPads do what Smorthoards can do plus more

literate. iPads do what Smartboards can do plus more.

Jo - it's definitely a philosophy thing. Each principal has their own approach.

Carrie - there is a staff request list and it is reviewed by a finance committee. It was decided to allocate the most to the library.

John - what proportion of our annual budget are we reallocating to this?

Jo - it's \$6970 for reallocation

John - what's the relationship between the iPads and the classes? Can the classes that have 1:1 ratio be reallocated?

Jo - the technology plan has nothing to do with the \$\$ that would be going towards purchasing iPads for the library. If there are questions around reallocating the money we can discuss

Carrie - reallocation of actual technology would be a staff conversation. Creating equity with new purchases is going to be better received than reallocation which could be perceived as taking away

VSB gives a small budget that has to be allocated across the school for different needs. The amount left over for tech is limited (about \$1000)

Jo - we don't typically have a tech or athletics line item

Motion to reallocate the \$6790 - Aaron Tamlin - Second

1 opposed 2 abstain

Motion carried

New Business: (30 mins)

- Recruitment for new PAC members from primary grades
 - Very important considering all the changes coming with seismic upgrades etc.
- Car Free Day Recruitment of co-organizer
 - Happening on Father's day
 - If we don't get a volunteer, we likely won't do it again
 - o If you know anyone interested, please have them reach out
 - Volunteer shifts are an hour two hours
 - It's strictly a community event it's kid-driven and not a money making venture
- Seismic Upgrade brief update on where we are at as of today; parent committee meeting post PAC meeting for anyone that would like to be involved.
 - Even if we have one person show up at meetings it's good because it shows our community cares
 - Chris nothing new to report it was a summary of what was presented at the school
 - They were impressed at the participation from the community
 - Accessibility was the main call out
 - Safety issues are being put forward
 - Lots of questions from trustees around past success
 - Now it's wait and see
 - We need to have a presence there
 - We are lucky considering there are school closures happening
 - Questions about water bottle stations (plan is to add two)
 - Trustee liaison is Carmen Cho
 - More information to come and we'll work hard to keep our faces present
