# How to Participate

Each student will receive a Walk-a-thon Pledge Form (attached to this page). Students can collect pledges from family (near or far), friends and neighbours to support their walk. Supporters can either give one donation or pledge to donate based on your goal - number of steps, distance or laps of a specific area.

With our Walk-a-thon being virtual this year, the options are endless. You can make your Walk-a-thon a hike, head to the forest or the beach, or just explore our incredible neighbourhood. You can also include your family in your adventure (please ensure you are following current public health requirements and practice social distancing when necessary). We encourage everyone to get outside and have some fun! **Our goal is to walk 750 km's or approximately 1 million steps as a school community** (including students and family members).

All pledge forms need to be returned to the office the week of June 7-11 and placed in the Walk-a-thon bin.

# 2021 Walk-a-thon Challenges

**All in the Family Challenge -** Challenge your family of close friends to join you (please ensure you are following public health orders and practicing social distancing when necessary).

**Trash Buster Challenge -** Make the most of your walk and clean-up our community on the way. Pick-up at least 10 pieces of trash and deposit into the appropriate receptacle.
